Youth Leadership Cleveland is a program of the Cleveland/Bradley Chamber of Commerce. The Youth Leadership program seeks to develop young leaders who will have a positive impact on the growth and development of the Cleveland/Bradley community, their schools, and beyond. This 8-month program will give students a front row seat to local services, businesses, and resources vital to a thriving community, while shaping and expanding personal development.

Participation in Youth Leadership Cleveland is open to rising sophomores, juniors, and seniors who live in Bradley County or attend a Bradley County or Cleveland City school. Admittance is free, but limited. A selection committee chooses participants based upon the information provided with this application and a current transcript provided by the school. The selection committee seeks representation from a variety of clubs and extra-curriculars to reflect the diversity of the student body.

SCHEDULE

Opening Retreat

Youth Leadership begins with an opening retreat held in July/August. Designed to create a team atmosphere amongst the participants, this retreat will provide the foundation for the Youth Leadership program. The opening retreat is mandatory to participate in the program. The orientation day will end with the opportunity for parents to meet the Chamber staff and volunteer leaders.

Day Sessions

These monthly sessions introduce students to a variety of community assets. Each session will include interacting with community leaders pertaining to the day session topic allowing students to gain a deeper understanding and engage in meaningful discussions.
